







<p>Work should be completed in pencil</p> 	<p>Work should always be dated</p> 	<p>Underline LO & copy correctly</p> <p><u>LO... present our work perfectly</u></p>							
<p>Titles are always underlined with a ruler</p> 	<p>Write on every page – don't waste space!</p> 	<p>Write SC under the LO or in the margin in green pen</p> 							
<p>Any written work should be on the lines close together</p> 	<p>Setting out calculations - put one digit per square E.g.</p> <table border="1" data-bbox="639 1440 916 1507"><tr><td>1</td><td>4</td><td>5</td><td>6</td></tr></table>	1	4	5	6	<p>Write decimal points in middle of two adjacent squares E.g. 2.5 is written as</p> <table border="1" data-bbox="1094 1447 1243 1507"><tr><td>2</td><td>.</td><td>5</td></tr></table>	2	.	5
