
Google Classroom





This is your stream where your teacher will post work.


You can also use it to post comments and chart with friends.

How to find, complete and turn in assignments



Click on the classwork button to find where all of your work is saved.

You will see that your teacher has saved documents and files for you to use to help you complete your work.

Sometimes, your teacher will give you a Google Docs file. This is like a word document that you canwrite on and then 'turn it in' so that your teacher can mark it. It's just like being at school!

When you're finished, siomply click the TURN IN tab and it will be sent to your teacher.
