As you may know, state schools in England are facing their worst decline in funding since 2010. Government funding has been declining for years, and while the school is diligent in managing its tight budget, there is only so much cutting that can be done before our children's school experience is affected.

We want to protect what makes our school special, and this Foundation allows our community to provide that support.

An Early Success Story!

Thanks to the incredible generosity of parents who donated just before summer 2025, the Foundation has already funded a new Teaching Assistant for the school. This additional presence will have a significant impact on improving pupil behaviour and engagement in the classroom and improving academic progress, as outlined in the Department for Education research report (2024) into the use of TA's in schools.

Our Goals for 2025-2026

This school year, our ambitions are even bigger. The Foundation aims to raise funds for:

- Two additional Teaching Assistants
- An Artist in Residence (1 day a week) to work on termly art projects with classes
- A Modern Foreign Languages in Residence (1 day a week)
- Digital technology to upgrade interactive Whiteboards and purchase more iPads
